APPLICATION FOR ANNUAL DEER CROSSBOW PERMIT

RSA 208:7-a Fis 301.041

The Deer Crossbow Permit must be renewed annually; it allows the permittee to take a deer with a crossbow during the regular hunting season, using a crossbow as your weapon and **following the same rules and regulations of that season including WMU restrictions**. You must use your firearm deer tag. This permit is only available from the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department in Concord. Crossbows shall be used in compliance with Fis 303.041. A copy of these rules and the Crossbow Hunting Safety brochure will be sent with your permit.

Permanent Crossbow Permit Holders: Those holding a permanent crossbow permit under RSA 207:10-c, for certain persons with a permanent disability; do not need to purchase this annual deer crossbow permit. You must purchase a regular hunting license and follow the same restrictions using your firearm deer tag and following the firearm regulations for each WMU.

Minors: An annual deer crossbow permit is not required for applicants under 16 years of age. They must be accompanied by a properly licensed adult, who has an annual deer permit to take deer with a crossbow. *However a crossbow cannot be used for a weapon during Special Youth Hunting Days for Deer.*
