

ATTENTION SMALL GAME HUNTERS TAKE THE 2010/2011 SMALL GAME SURVEY

THIS YEAR WE ARE PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THAT WE ARE HOLDING A DRAWING FOR A STURM RUGER ALL WEATHER HAWKEYE RIFLE, IN YOUR CHOICE OF CALIBER, FOR THOSE WHO RETURN A COMPLETED SMALL GAME SURVEY.

SURVEY GUIDELINES

When filling out the survey, PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

- Only record **YOUR** 2010-2011 **small game hunting** observations;
- The small game season can be divided into 2 reporting periods: October 1-December 31, and January 1 – March 31. If you hunt during both recording periods, you can submit your information on 2 surveys, one by January 15, and the other by April 15;
- Enter your daily hunting observations sequentially. Your survey accommodates 14 days of hunting information. Feel free to submit multiple pages of the survey if you would like to report more than 14 days;
- If you don't see any small game when hunting, fill the appropriate column for that day with a zero;
- Include the Wildlife Management Unit and town in which you hunted. Please do not list village names. We will NOT publish town results;
- Note that the last column of the survey is intended to identify the game species you were "**PRINCIPALLY HUNTING FOR**". If your principal pursuit was woodcock, place "WO" in the blocks, if it was a gray squirrel place "SQ" in the blocks, etc. Note that the 2-letter abbreviation for each species of interest is highlighted on the survey form.
- **Only fill out the survey on the days you are principally hunting one of the small game species we have listed;**
- Please return your completed survey for the appropriate reporting period (either January 15th or April 15th) to NH Fish and Game Dept., 11 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH 03301, Attn: Wildlife Division. **ALL COMPLETED SURVEYS MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN APRIL 15, 2011, OR THE SURVEY WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN OUR DRAWING;**
- A brief summary report will be distributed to survey respondents upon its completion.
